Ladies Heart to Heart



Recently I found myself doing one of those mundane chores we know are necessary, but we often neglect. It's not that it's difficult or even gross, just time-consuming. I had to clean out my pantry.

I found several boxes of the same item opened. I found expired items. I found items that were stale and no longer usable. It was unorganized and chaotic. Items that should be stored next to one another for convenience were scattered among the shelves. The most surprising revelation was that my pantry was really wasn't as full as it looked.

It occurred to me that our lives are like that- especially as mothers. There are some tasks of motherhood that just seem so mundane we dread to do them. Laundry, dishes, diapering, cooking-I could go on and on. We often don't really see the value in them...until they aren't done!

How long would you be able to function if you didn't do the laundry? Eventually you would run out of clothes. The same could be said for your dishes. How long would your budget hold up if you constantly ate out or did pick up for meals? And well diapering?? Do I even need to ask?!

We all love those "big moments" of motherhood: birth, learning to walk, learning to talk and ride a bike, graduation, and even marriage. These often make the scrapbooks of our heart, but if you ask your child(ren) what's their favorite memory you may be surprised. It usually unpacks some random story about their favorite meal or a time when you did what seemed almost mundane, but it left a deep impression- like throw the ball with them or take them for ice cream.

Moms be encouraged! Stay consistent in your love and sacrifice for your kids. We may not even get some of those "big moments". Maybe your child said "Da-da" first or someone else taught them to ride a bike. But I can guarantee that what impacts them the most is what you do for them ALL THE TIME. Those acts of love and service you do daily to make their lives fruitful.

Above all make sure you consistently point them to God. Use the everyday to make a point. Talk about the daily news stories, encourage them with a scripture, live out the love of God that they may see it in action. Deuteronomy 6:7 tells us to take the commands and teachings of the Lord and "repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up" (NLT). It's that daily impact that makes such an impression on the souls of our children. You may just find that God interrupts your mundane with a miraculous moment!

Am I showing my family how a woman walks in <u>righteousness</u>; talks or acts in difficult situations? Or, am I falling apart, cussing and acting a plum fool?


